

The City of Hickory Planning and Development Services Department, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the City's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located between 2,818 feet downstream of the 46th Avenue Drive Northeast bridge to 1,188 feet upstream of the 46th Avenue Drive Northeast bridge. Specifically, the flood hazard information shall be revised from a point 4,999 feet upstream of the confluence of Snow Creek and Lake Hickory to a point 9,005 feet upstream of the confluence of Snow Creek and Lake Hickory.

As a result of the revision, the floodway shall widen, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall decrease, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall narrow within the area of revision.
