

Wastewater Report  
Available For Citizens To Review

The 2021-2022 City of Hickory Wastewater Report is now available for citizens to review.

The yearly report gives customers an opportunity to review detailed information on the performance of the City's collection system and treatment facilities. In 1999, the State required that Owners and Operators of Wastewater Treatment Plants provide an Annual Report to its customers, and this is the twenty-second annual report that has been released to the Public by the City of Hickory.

North Carolina House Bill 1160, also known as the Clean Water Act of 1999, was ratified by the North Carolina General Assembly on July 20, 1999, and signed into law by the Governor on July 21, 1999. This legislation placed significant reporting requirements on entities that own and operate Collection Systems and Wastewater Treatment Facilities. Owners and operators of systems that treat municipal or domestic wastewater are required to provide an annual report to customers and users, and to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. The annual reports must be submitted within 60 days of the end of the applicable 12-month review period.
