CITY OF HICKORY SPAY/NEUTER PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- 1) Participants must be residents of the City of Hickory.
- 2) Participants must have an individual annual income of \$20,000 or less, or a household income of \$25,000 or less.
- 3) The City of Hickory will pay designated veterinarians half of the cost of the spay/neuter of a pet. Under this program, participating area veterinarians will charge \$70 for the spay/neuter of a dog (any size). **Cost to the participant is \$35.** Participating veterinarians will charge \$50 for the spay/neuter of a cat. **Cost to the participant is \$25.**
 - If necessary, dogs and cats will be given rabies and distemper combination vaccinations. Veterinarian charges for dog vaccination is \$30. **Cost to participant is \$15.** Veterinarian charge for cat vaccination is \$26. **Cost to participant is \$13.**
 - **Participants are responsible for paying the balance of the cost of spaying or neutering and vaccination of their animal at the time of the surgery.**
- 4) Through this program, there may be one pet spayed or neutered per household, per fiscal year (July 1 through June 30). This may be waived on a case by case basis.
- 5) Program participants will be responsible for making the necessary appointment with the veterinarian and transporting their animal to the veterinarian at the time of the appointment.
- 6) The animal should be six months or older.
- 7) Participants should choose from one of the following veterinarians:
