### Items to Recycle

- + RINSE all food & drink containers
- + all plastic bottles and containers (#1 - #2)
- + wide-mouth plastic containers & lids
- + mixed paper, newspapers with inserts, junk mail
- + computer paper, office paper, color paper, envelopes
- + gift wrapping paper (without foil backing)
- + magazines, telephone books, paperback books
- + cardboard, gift boxes, shoe boxes (flattened)
- + cereal & food boxes (no food debris)
- + milk & juice cartons & boxes (must be empty)
- + aluminum cans, steel cans including lids
- + aluminum foil (no food debris)
- + glass bottles & jars (all colors)

### Items NOT to Recycle

- plastic bags, plastic film or wrap
- batteries
- food & candy wrappers
- styrofoam
- waxed cardboard
- rubber or tires
- hazardous waste, electronics & paint
- glassware or light bulbs
- clothing or fabric
- household garbage or food waste
- tangelers - hangers or cords of any kind
- TO-GO containers, straws, lids or utensils

### Take Note

- 11-05-22 - Household Hazardous Waste Event
- 11-14-22 - Leaf Season Begins

- \*Remove your rollouts from the curb the same day as your service day.
- \*How you put ALL items to the curb matters, so know how before you do!!!
